Veronica Burns was born in Mudgee and spent her childhood on her family's property at Hill End. She studied Fashion and Textile Design at Sydney College of the Arts, Balmain and worked as a textile designer before setting up her own design business. In 1994 she moved with her husband, author and publisher Tony Macdougall, to the South West Slopes but is moving within days to Mudgee where she was born.

A lifelong enthusiasm for printed surfaces, whether fabric, ceramics or glass has taken Veronica's career from textile design and screen printed/hand-painted ceramic tiles to kiln-formed glass.

Veronica finds glass the most fascinating medium to work with. Its transparency and ability to bend as well as carry pattern and colour makes it a most versatile material. The glass in this exhibition is part of her production range and is screen printed and hand painted. It is recommended that it not be put into a microwave oven or dishwasher.
